

## Recommended Street Trees for the Richmond-EI Sobrante, CA Area

Street trees should be able to tolerate exposure to reflected light and heat from pavement, have moderate growth, be shapely, may provide shade, add character to the street, and be relatively easy to maintain. Trees for the Carriage Hills development(s) should also tolerate lawn watering, as many homes have lawn as part of the front yard.

### Some suggestions for Street Trees:

Scientific Name	Common Name	Comments
* <i>Gleditsia</i> spp	Thornless Honey Locust	Nice fall color
* <i>Zelkova serrata</i>	Zelkova	Beautiful leaves, neat
* <i>Ulmus parvifolia</i>	Chinese Elm	Bark, graceful shape
* <i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i>	Liquidamber	Fall Color, fruit
* <i>Fagus sylvatica</i>	Bronze Beech Tree	Leaf color, fruit/pod
* <i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Sour Gum	Fall Color, shade

### Other Trees for yard (non-Street Trees):

<i>Aesculus carnea</i>	Red Horsechestnut	Nice flowers, fruit
<i>Acer</i> spp.	Maple	Fall Color, leaves
<i>Cercis occidentalis</i>	Western Redbud	Spring flowers
<i>Crataegus</i> spp.	Crape Myrtle	Flowers, accent tree
<i>Oxydendron arboreus</i>	Sourwood	Fall Color, shade
<i>Pistachia chinensis</i>	Chinese Pistache Tree	Fall Color, fruit
